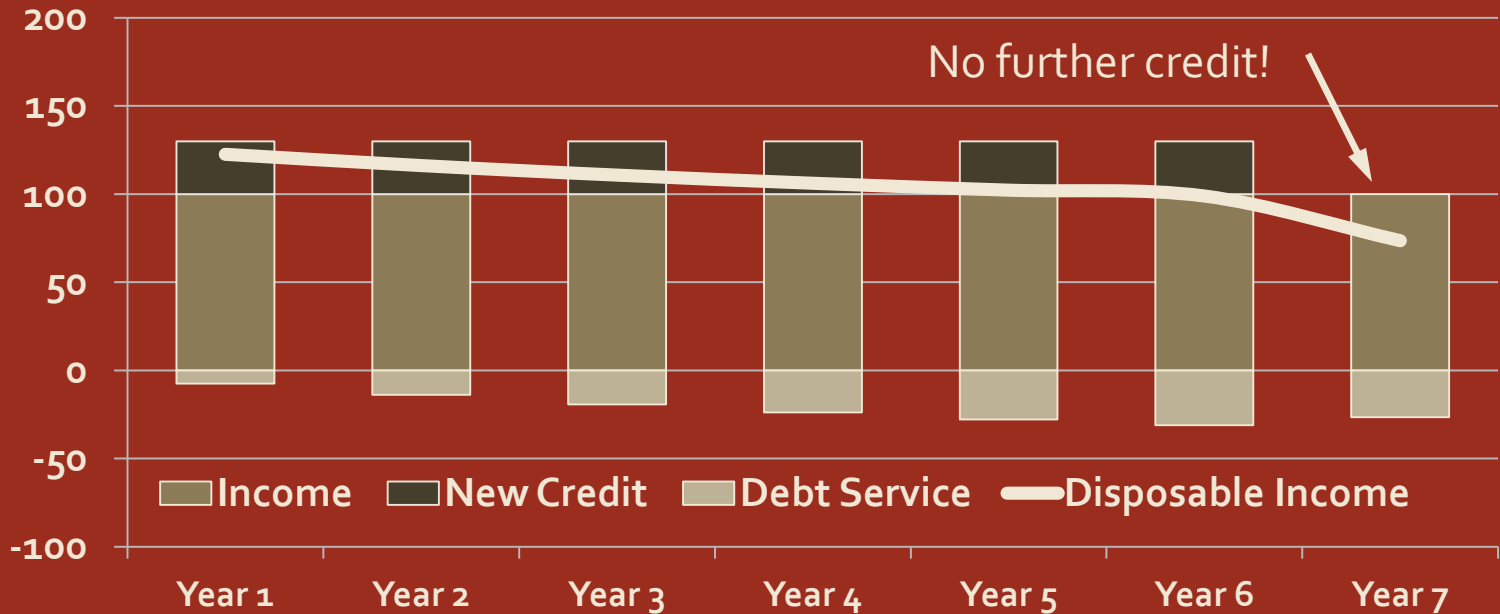

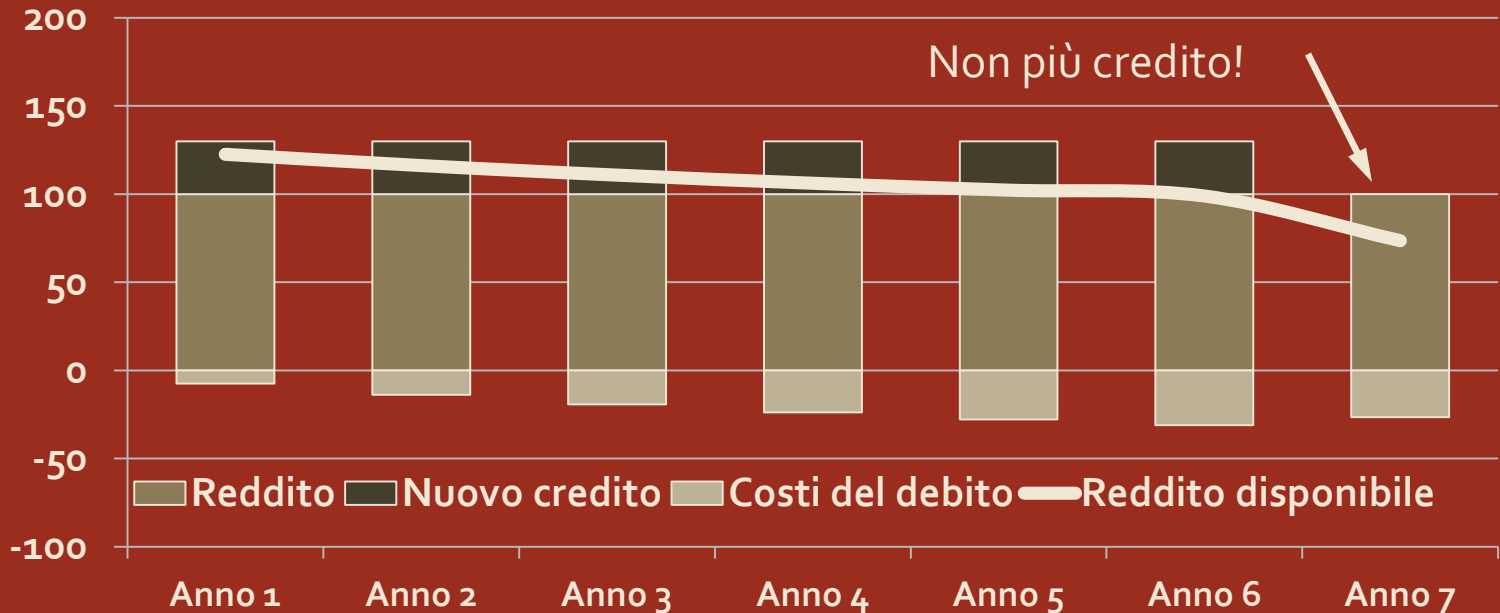

A (family) budget with debt

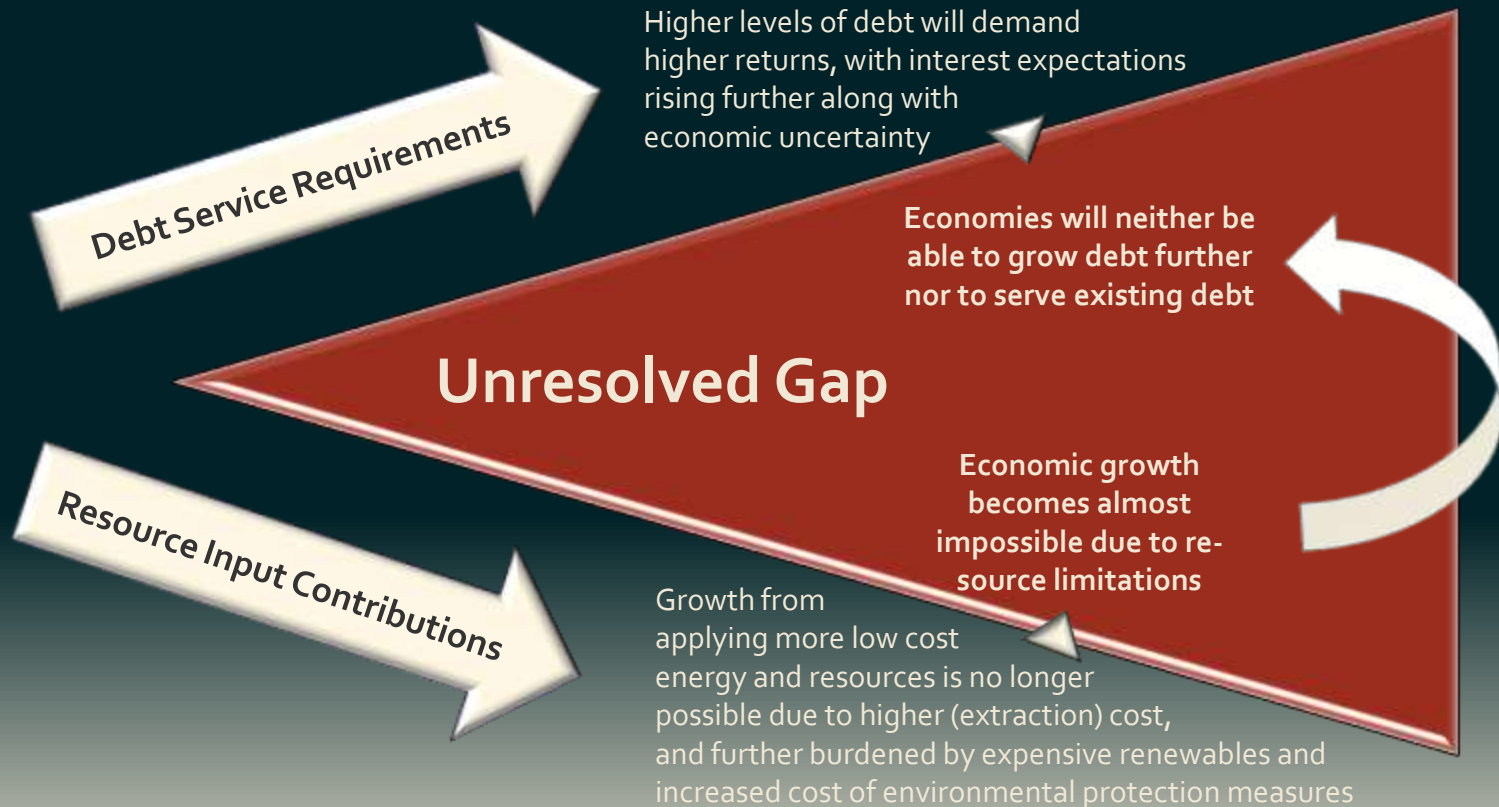

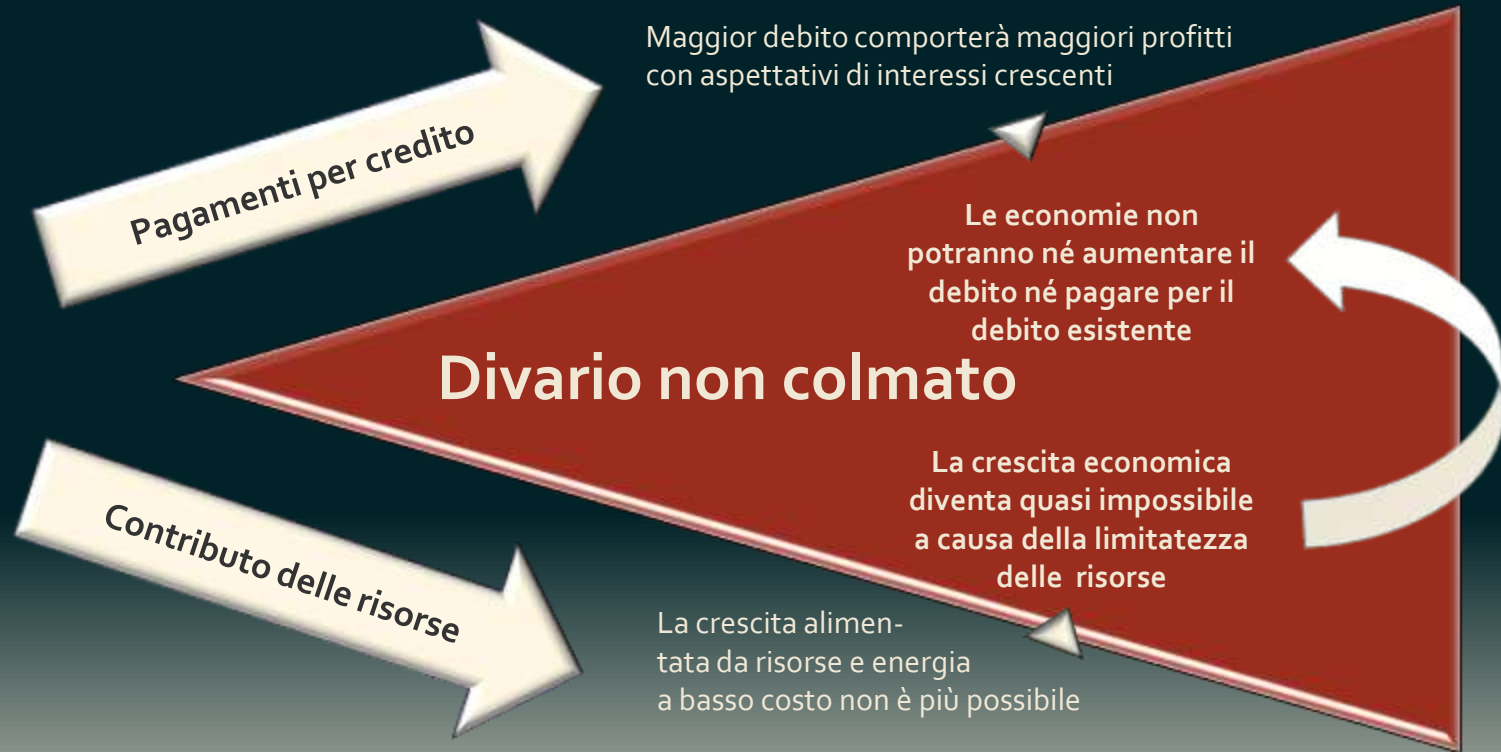
Un budget familiare con debito



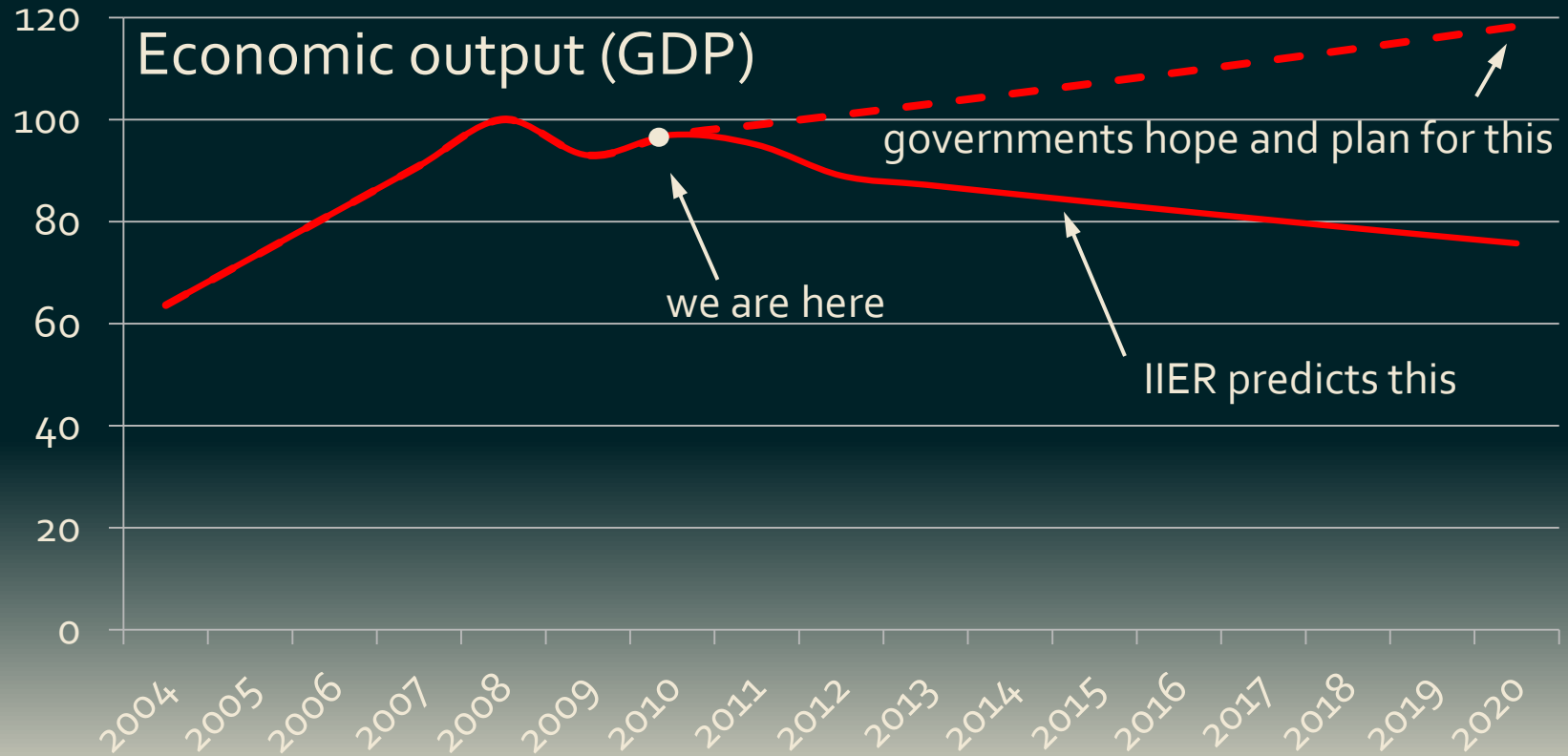
By now, the world economy is trapped



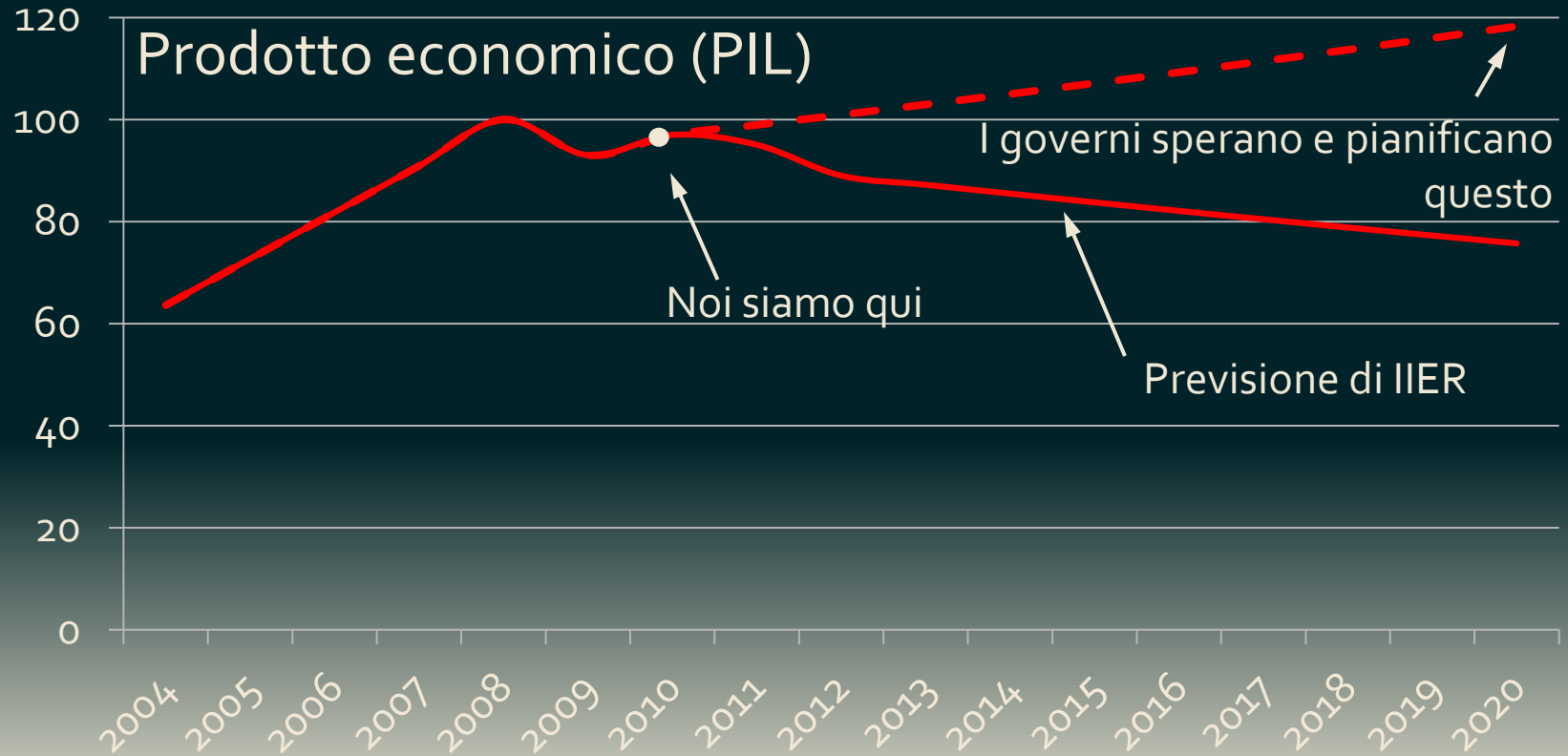
Oggi, l'economia mondiale é in trappola
