


Figure II-1: Ecological Footprint per capita in Israel by component, 1961-2008




Figure II-2: Contributing drivers of Israel's Ecological Footprint, 1961-2008




Figure II-3: Biocapacity per capita in Israel by component 1961-2008




Figure II-4: Contributing drivers of Israel's biocapacity, 1961-2008




Figure IL-5: Israel's per capita ecological deficit, 1961-2008




Figure IL-7: Israel's GDP by component, GNI, and ratio of national GNI per capita to world total GNI, 1961-2008




Figure IL-9: Israel's population by age group, 1961-2010




Figure IL-6: Israel's per capita ecological deficit by contributing land-use type, 1961-2008




Figure IL-8: Ecological Footprint and HDI for all countries, with Israel's trend for 1980-2008
