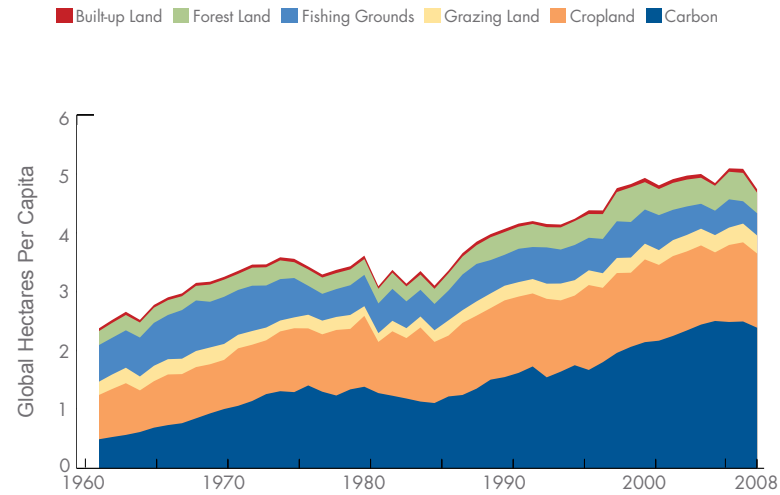


Figure ES-1: Ecological Footprint per capita in Spain by component, 1961-2008

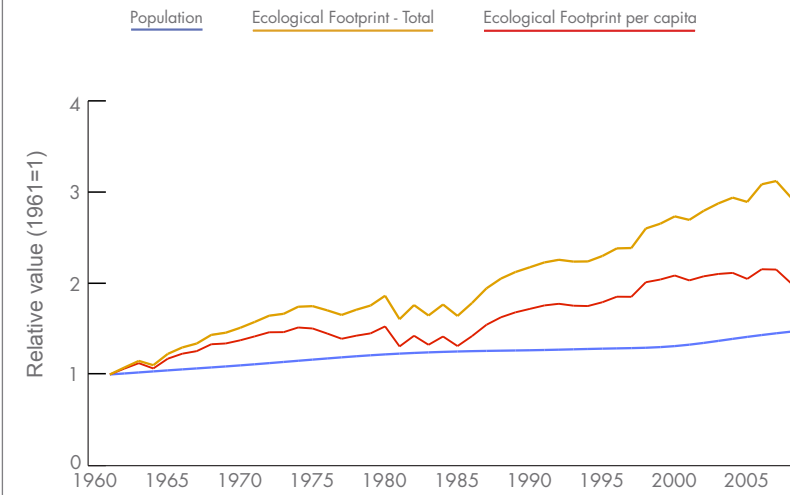


Figure ES-2: Contributing drivers of Spain's Ecological Footprint, 1961-2008

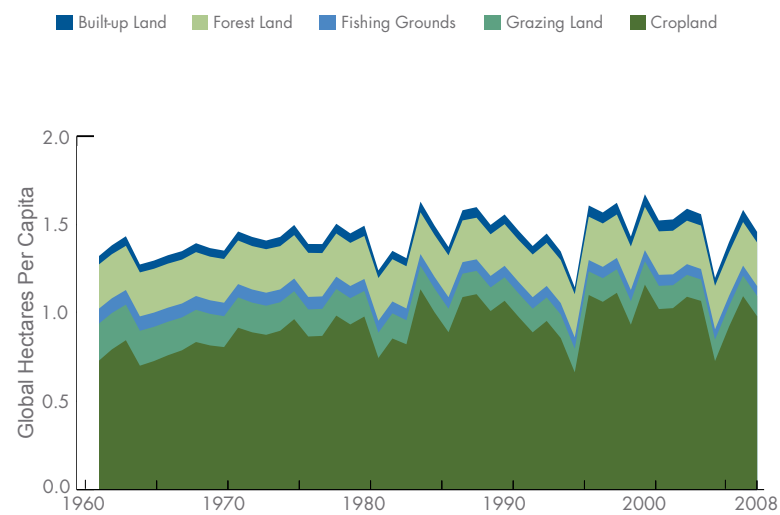


Figure ES-3: Biocapacity per capita in Spain by component 1961-2008

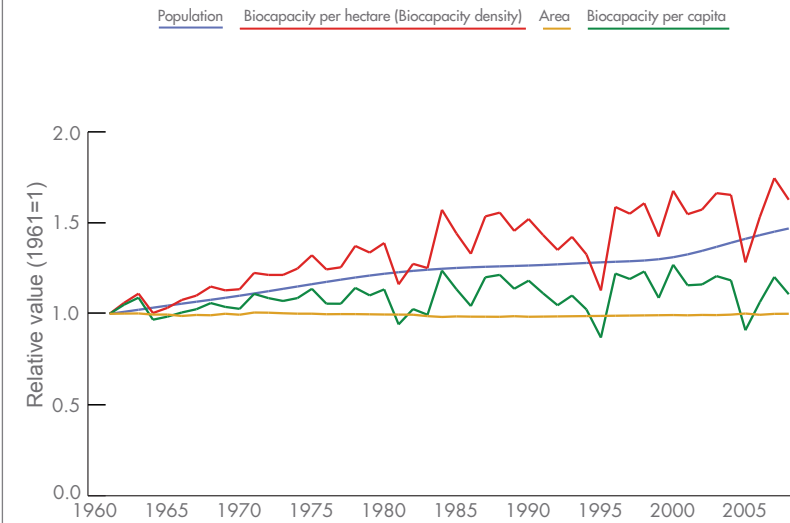


Figure ES-4: Contributing drivers of Spain's biocapacity, 1961-2008

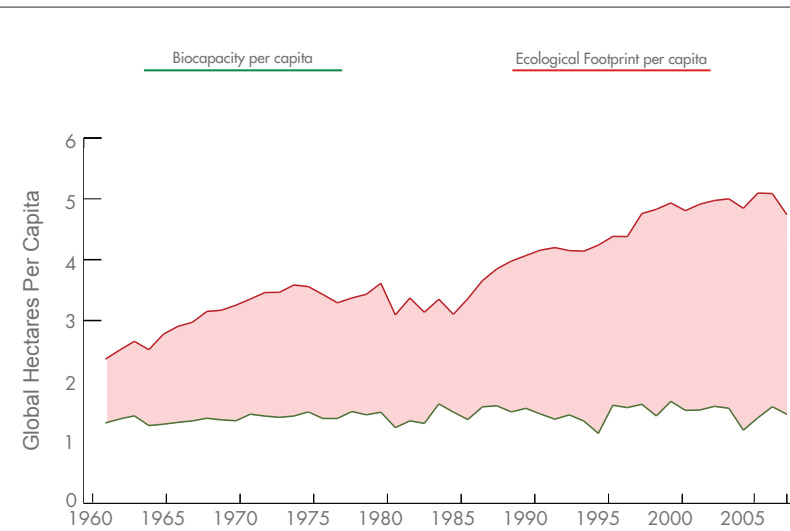


Figure ES-5: Spain's per capita ecological deficit, 1961-2008

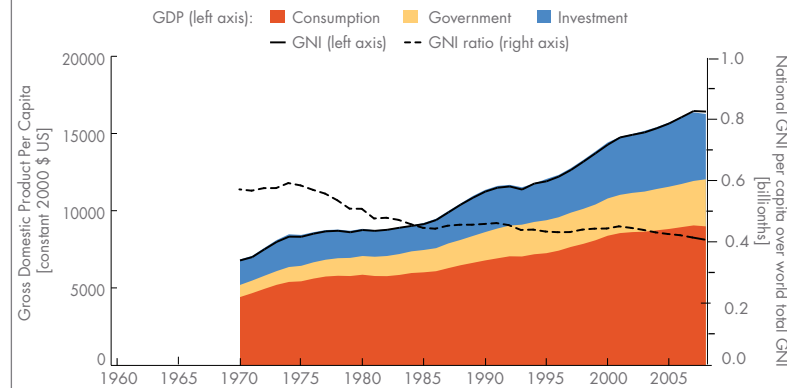


Figure ES-7: Spain's GDP by component, GNI, and ratio of national GNI per capita to world total GNI, 1961-2008

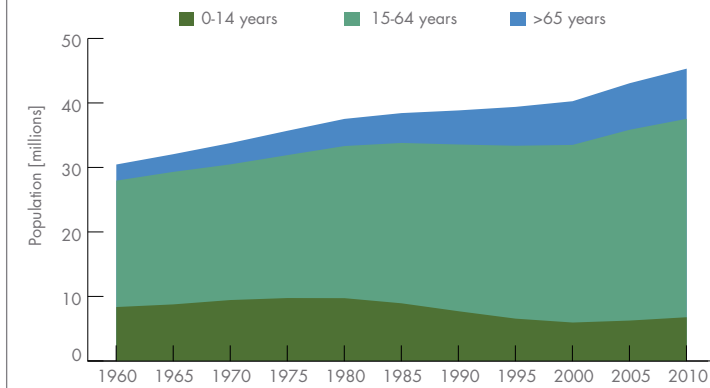


Figure ES-9: Spain's population by age group, 1961-2010

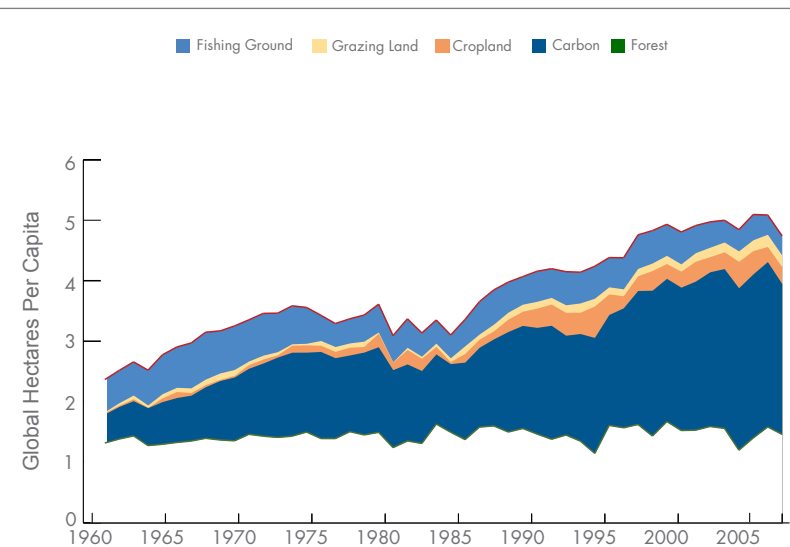


Figure ES-6: Spain's per capita ecological deficit by contributing land-use type, 1961-2008

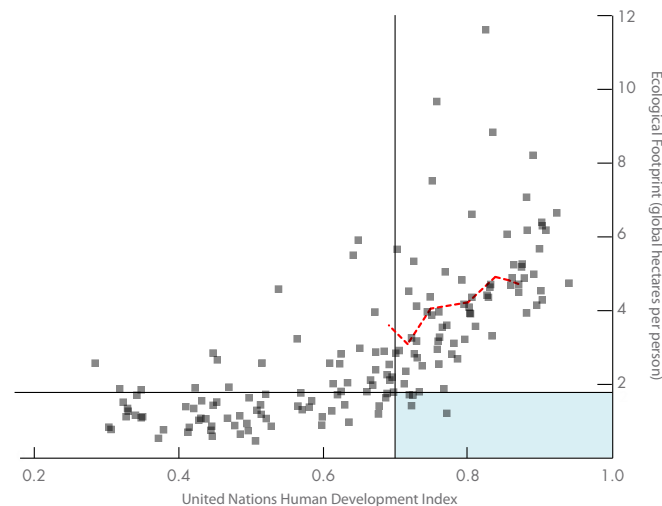


Figure ES-8: Ecological Footprint and HDI for all countries, with Spain's trend for 1980-2008
