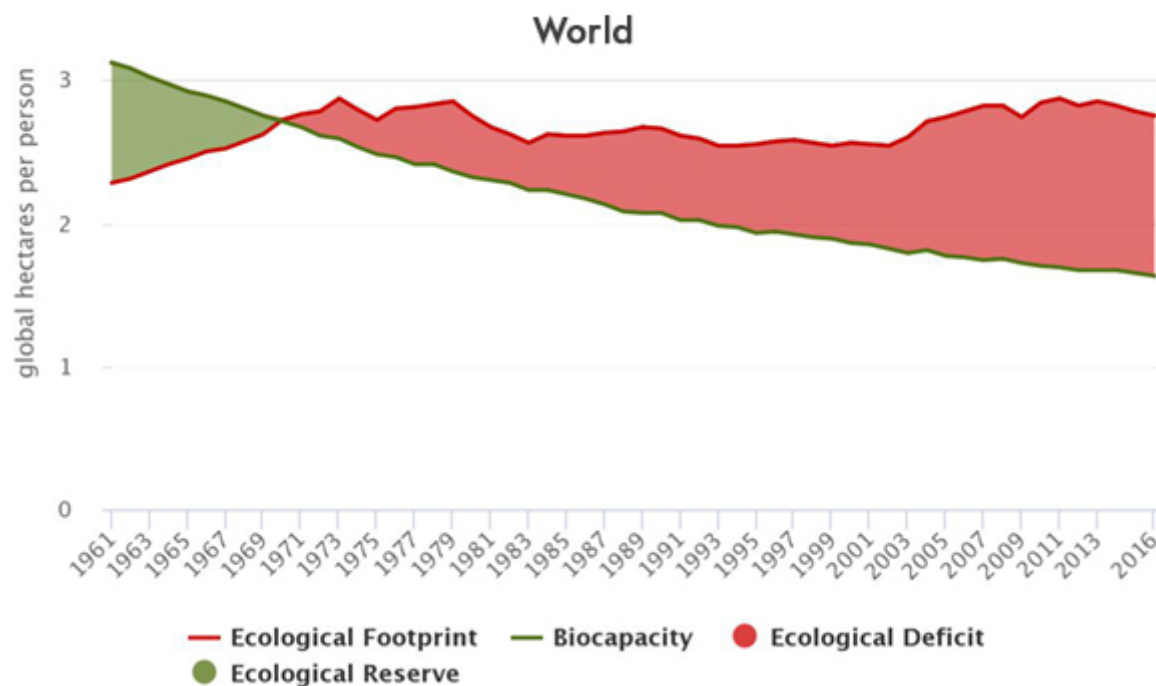

**The 2019 edition of the National Footprint and Biocapacity Accounts is out!**

Here are some highlights:

- Humanity's Ecological Footprint **decreased** between 2014 and 2016.
- The carbon Footprint accounts for **60%** of the total Ecological Footprint.
- **86%** of the world's population lives in a country with an ecological deficit.

Here is what changed in the 2019 edition:

- The calculations are based on 2016 data, giving us **two years worth of data** since last year's edition. That's because the delay in available data was shortened from three to two years due to improved United Nations' data processes.
- The Accounts were produced under the close observation of students in the Faculty of Environmental Studies as part of our Ecological Footprint Initiative with York University in Toronto.
